NIMBASH returned on September 11, 2021, with renewed energy and enthusiasm. Following COVID-safe protocols, the in-person event wowed over 400 art lovers and patrons. Held for the first time at the beautiful Charles Krug Winery, NIMBASH raised over \$750,000 to support Nimbus Arts programs, art scholarships and financial aid, and delivered more than \$149,566 in wages & commissions to our esteemed local

working artists. This year's "off-cycle" NIMBASH will be followed by NIMBASH 2022 on May 28th – so **Save the Date!**



Launching **Nim+BUS** took a big step ahead recently. Nimbus Arts is reviewing design specifications and program requirements with a leading manufacturer of customized activity vehicles. The result will be a complete design, production schedule and budget. While we've raised funds to complete design development and start work on Nim+BUS, we still need support to complete and activate our studio-on-wheels. Launching Nim+BUS will extend the community-building benefits of artmaking across Napa County. We'll bring Nim+BUS to schools, community gatherings, festivals, and events far and wide, and Nim+BUS will strengthen our mission to make art accessible and available to people of all ages and ability levels.

For the **Nimbus Arts Floating Pumpkin Exhibit** at Farmstead, 200 pumpkins sponsored by Long Meadow Ranch were acquired from St. Helena High School's FFA program and carved by families across Napa Valley. Then they were all put on display in the Farmstead demonstration garden from October 29-31 to



be enjoyed by both diners and visitors! We are grateful to Long Meadow Ranch for allowing us to use their beautiful garden and for sponsoring the 200 community pumpkins.

Nimbus Arts presented "Perch and Ponder: Owls of Remembrance," a Día de los Muertos Community Art Installation



celebrating the iconic owl. Over 100 free owl kits were distributed and completed by community members of all ages. The art installation was displayed for two weeks from October 25-November 7 in downtown St. Helena. This festive community art installation was generously sponsored by the City of St. Helena and the Arts Council Napa Valley. We are deeply thankful for their generosity

and for the generous construction support from Walker Building Co. and a special thank you to Laura Rombauer and Vintage Home for the exterior display space.

Our **13th annual Día de Los Muertos Celebration**, produced in conjunction with our longtime partner, The UpValley Family Centers, returned to the Upper Valley Campus of Napa Valley College, on Sunday, October 31. Hundreds of local families celebrated Mexican-American heritage and culture through art,

folkloric dance, family and community-made altars, music, food and great family-focused activities. Nimbus Arts created and distributed 250 free cultural art kits to the community at the event.

Hundreds of Hands™ #012; Wellness Wednesdays


